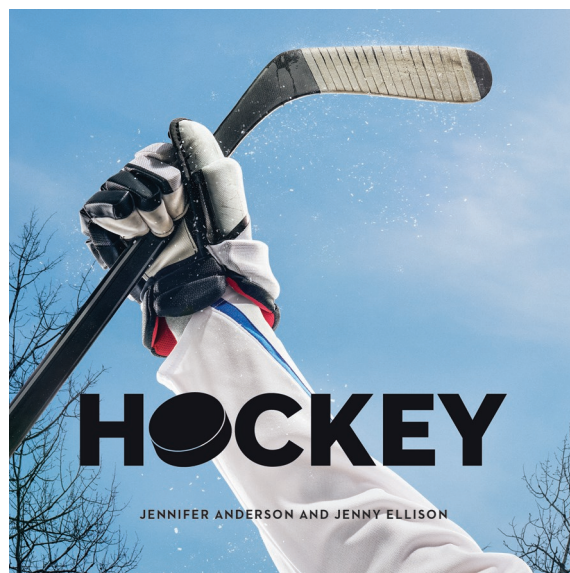


HOCKEY
